THE tuition industry will go under the microscope with a [survey](#) designed to allow parents to air their views.

Organised by the Australian Tutoring Association, the survey examines who is being tutored, the costs and types of tuition available, benefits and other major issues in the growing industry.

There is no clear indication of the sector's size or value because so much tutoring is done "off the books". This would be the first time such an extensive analysis of the industry was undertaken, ATA CEO Mohan Dhall said.

"The importance of information about who is being tutored is that it will demonstrate what the point is when families decide to take on tutors," Mr Dhall said.
